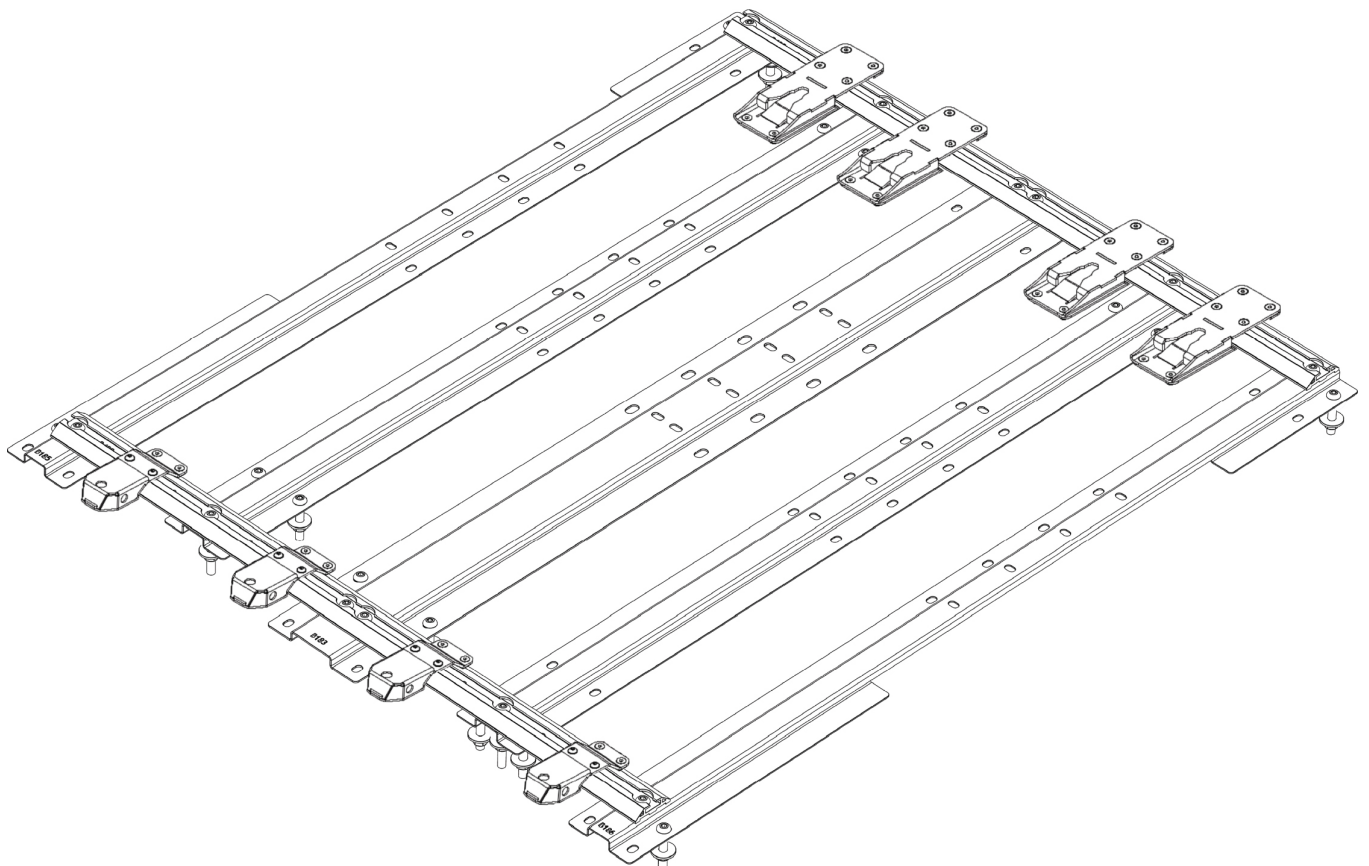

Important Information:

- This Installation Instruction Manual is for the accurate, safe and secure attachment of the 1400 Mounting Platform, and Catch-and-Click™ Brackets to the vehicle.
- Open all kits to check that all parts are present.
- Follow all assembly steps in this Instruction Manual.
- Do not skip steps.
- Do not leave out any fastener components from the installation steps.
- It is recommended to review the vehicle and crosscheck before making any modifications. Check to avoid damaging critical vehicle components beneath the ute tub bed before drilling pilot holes or larger through holes.
- Aftermarket tub-liners can vary significantly between vehicles of the same model. The KUFU Mounting Platform should be securely attached to the steel floor of the ute tub. Removing some of the tub liner material allows space needed to raise and level the Mounting Platform above different liner profiles. Follow this manual to remove the tub-liner around the bolt locations to allow for a level and safe installation.
- Use Spacer Disc parts provided to create a level installation.
- Tub-liners and roller-covers can remain in the ute tub. However, please check to ensure the KUFU Drawer System to-be installed is suitable and will not interfere with these types of accessories.

For example: 280mm and 460mm height drawers and any spacer discs required will interfere with most roller-covers. Please double check the available ute bed height before proceeding with the installation.

Mounting platform heights with no spacer disc:

Type A = 23mm

Type B = 23mm

Type C & MC = 15mm.

- Depending on the tub and clearances required – spacer discs maybe required, which will increase the overall drawer height.
- Reference installation manual step 14 for spacer disc size to calculate overall drawer height when installed.
- All care is taken to provide spacer disc sizing, however due modifications or other aftermarket products, such as tail gate limit straps, struts and covers and tub liners, spacer discs may need to be increased or decreased to clear openings and fit under roll tops
- Some ute tubs have different supporting channels beneath the tub floor, these run laterally across the tub. If the pilot holes and subsequent through holes are positioned on top of these channel areas, longer bolts and crush tubes may be required to support the tightening of fasteners to secure the Mounting Platform without crushing the channel of the ute tub.
- It is recommended to inform the insurance provider for the vehicle of any modifications additions or accessories added to the vehicle, these may affect the ability to make claims depending on the level and or type of cover.
- The KUFU Drawer System and associated Mounting Platforms and Bracket Parts are designed for repeated use. However, wear and tear will occur due to the nature of different materials in the assemblies and installations.

STEP 1 - Installation Preparation:

1. Remove all unattached items from the ute bed.
2. Clean the ute bed.

STEP 2 - Tools Required:

- Hex Drive or Allen Key Set
- Socket Set or Spanner Set
- Powered Drill
- Drill Bits up to 10mm
- Marker - Not black
- Utility Knife
- Tape Measure
- 50mm Hole-saw

STEP 3 - Unpack Mounting Platform:

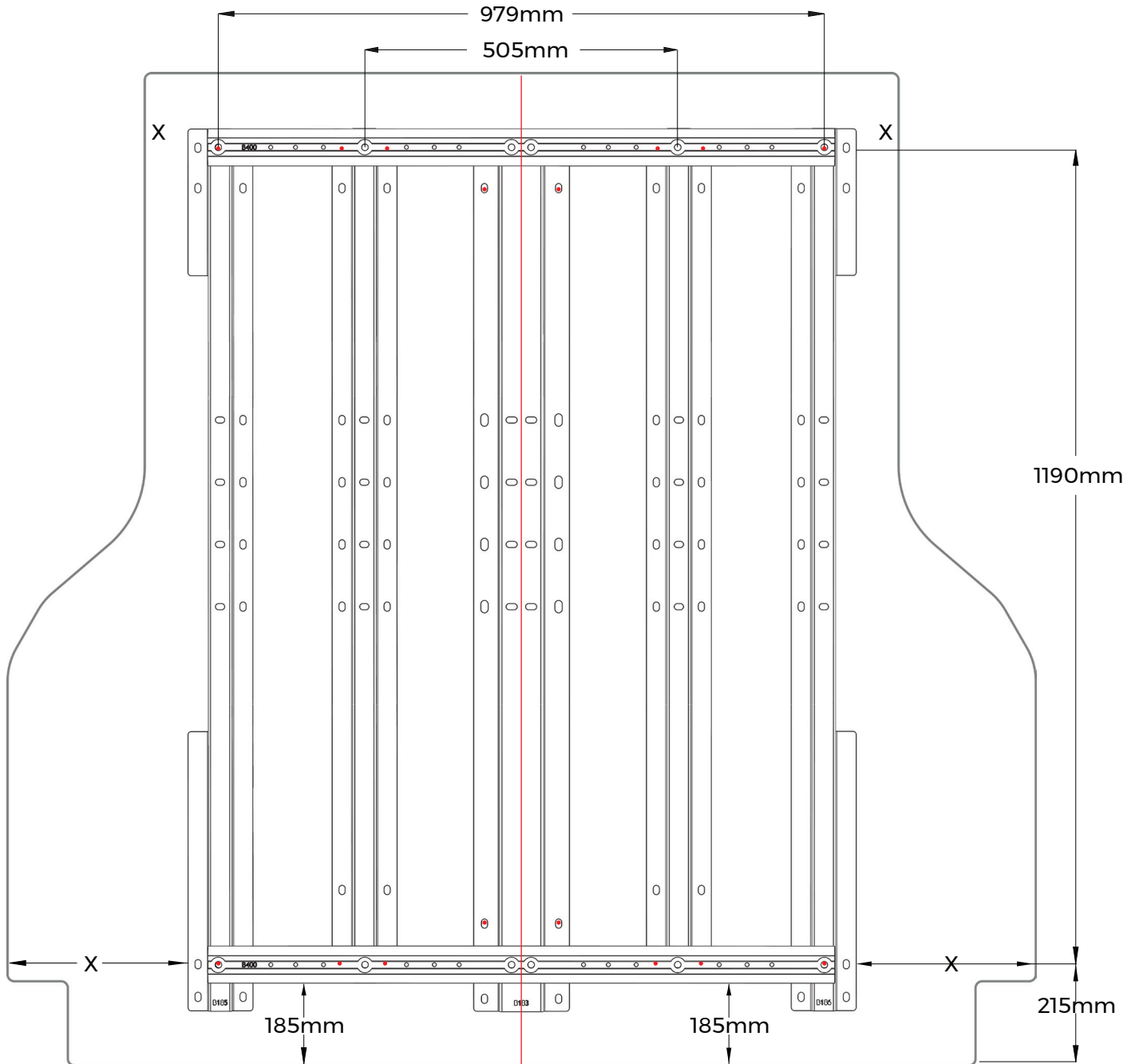

STEP 4 - Layout the Rails:

- Accurately measure and mark the centreline of the tub - Critical to successful fitment.

IMPORTANT - B400 RAIL UPDATE

B400 rails are now supplied in halves. Maintain a 5 mm gap between the B400 half rails when fixing them to the Type MC mounting platform.

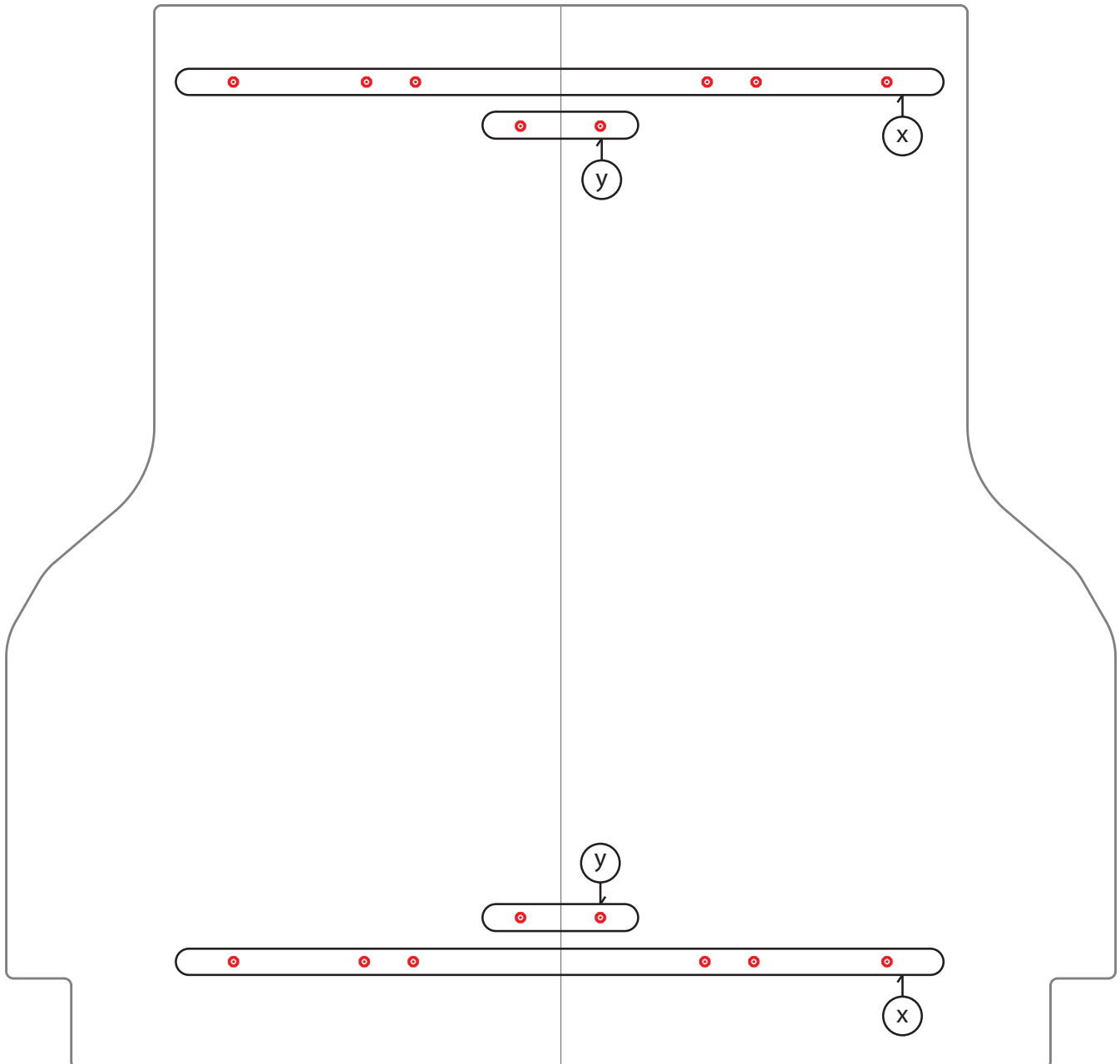
- Position the forward B400 half rails (tailgate end) 185 mm from the inside of the closed tailgate and centred. Measure X distances on either side to confirm the rails are centred. Mark only the holes indicated with RED DOTS for drilling pilot holes.
- **DO NOT mark or drill holes that are not marked with RED DOTS.**
- Position the rearward B400 half rails (cabin end) with the rail M10 mounting holes 1190 mm centre to centre. Centre the rails using the marked centreline and equal X distances. Mark only the RED DOT holes for drilling pilot holes.
- Position the vertical rails and mark only the holes indicated with RED DOTS.



NOTE: Check underneath the ute tub to avoid damaging critical vehicle components before drilling pilot holes or larger through holes.

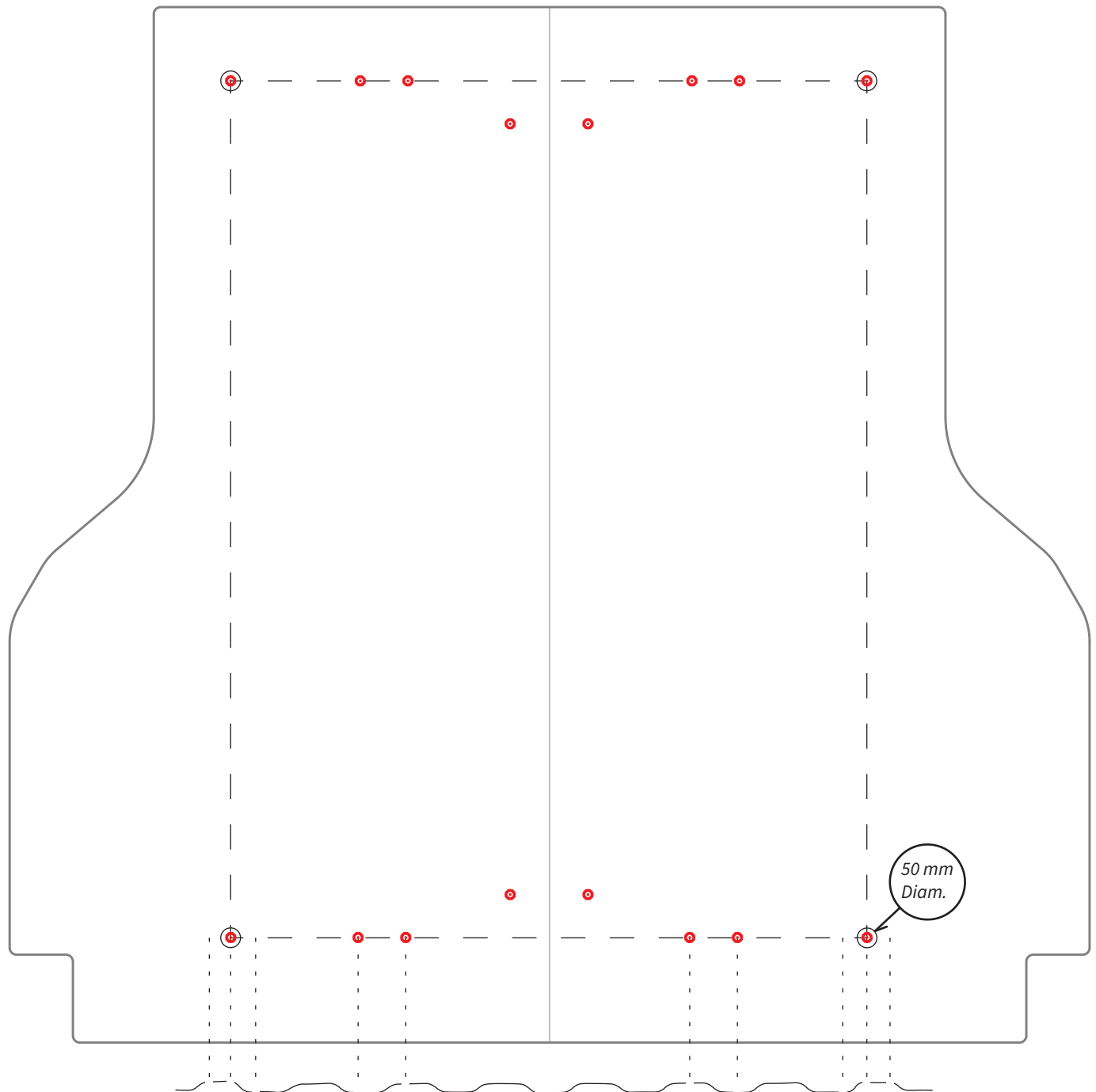
STEP 5 - Drill the Pilot Hole Positions:

- Remove the B400 rails – make sure your marker in **Step 4** has marked the 22 x M10 hole positions.
- Drill a 3mm pilot hole in the marked positions X and Y shown diagram.



STEP 6 - Hole-Saw the Tub-liner:

- Saw 50mm holes through the Tub-liner material only at the pilot hole locations.
- **DO NOT** hole-saw the ute tub steel floor.

STEP 6 Continued - Hole-Saw the Tub-liner:

NOTE: Aftermarket tub-liners can vary significantly between vehicles of the same model.

The KUFU Mounting Platform is compatible to both Ribbed Tub-liner (Image 1) and Flat Tub-liner (Image 2), the KUFU Mounting platform should be securely attached to the steel floor of the ute tub.

Removing some of the Tub-liner material allows space needed to raise and level the Mounting Platform above different liner profiles. Follow this manual to remove the tub-liner around the bolt locations to allow for a level and safe installation.

- Use Spacer Disc parts provided to create a level installation in the next steps.



Image 1 : Ribbed Tub-liner.



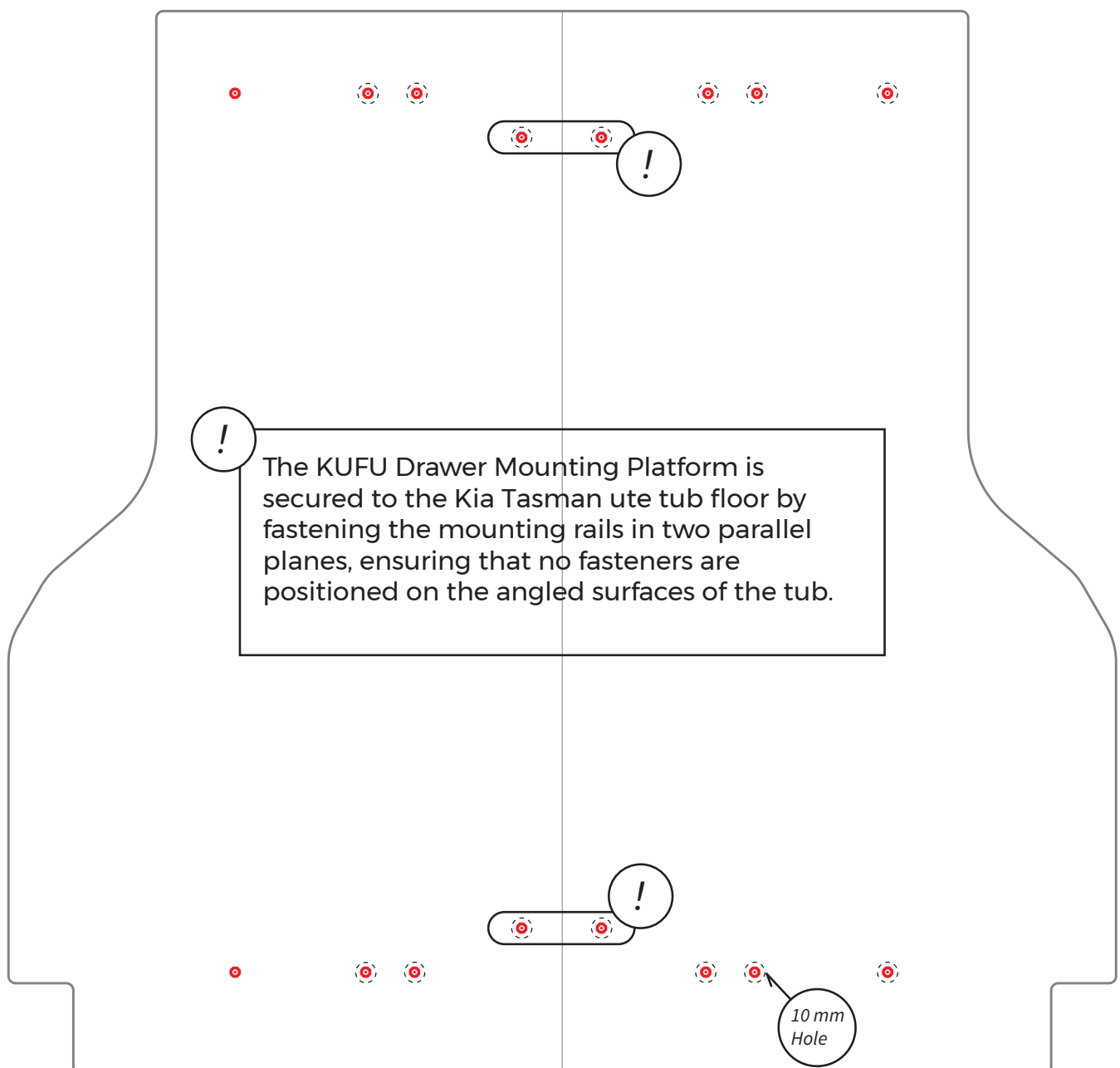
Image 2 : Flat Tub-liner.

STEP 7 - Drill the through Holes:

NOTE: Check underneath the ute tub thoroughly to avoid damaging critical vehicle components before drilling holes.

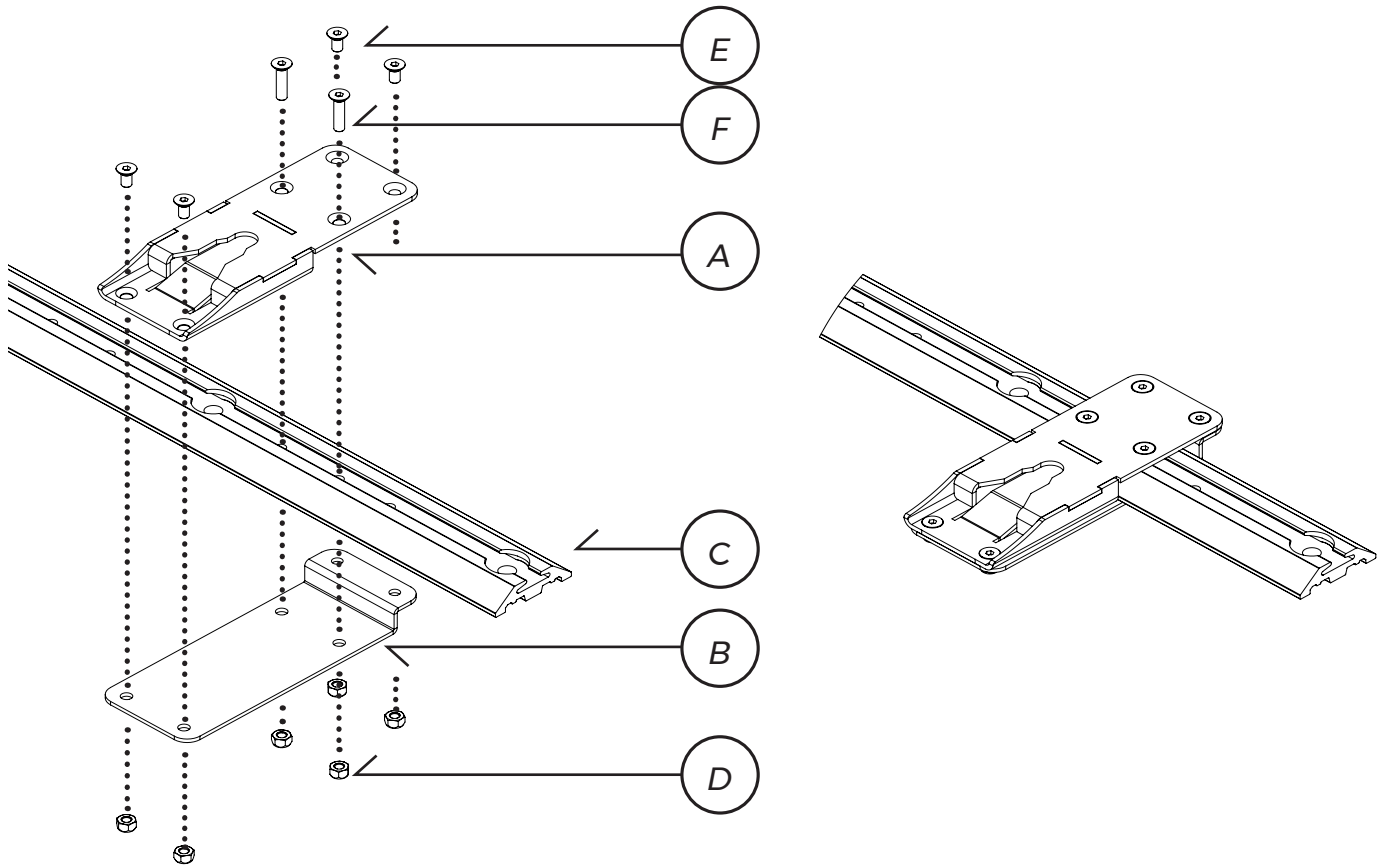
- Drill a 10mm through hole in the pilot hole positions from previous step.

TIP: Use a step-drill instead of a twist drill bit if there is critical vehicle components beneath a hole position. A step-drill is shorter and will not protrude as far through the hole as a twist drill bit that can potentially cause damage.





- Layout and position the B185, B186, B187, B183 rails, make sure the CNC CUT of the mentioned numbers in the rails are at the tailgate end over the drilled 10mm holes. (as shown above)



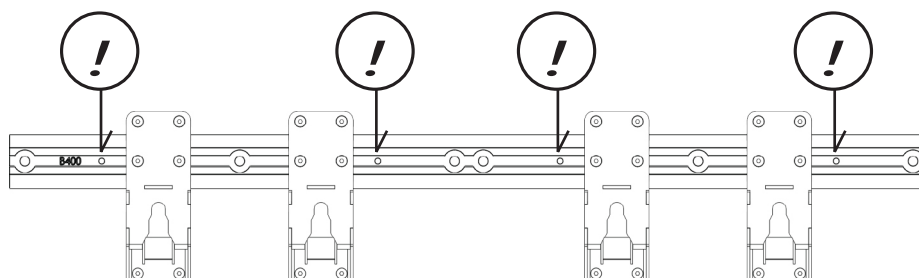
STEP 9 - Catch Brackets Assembly:

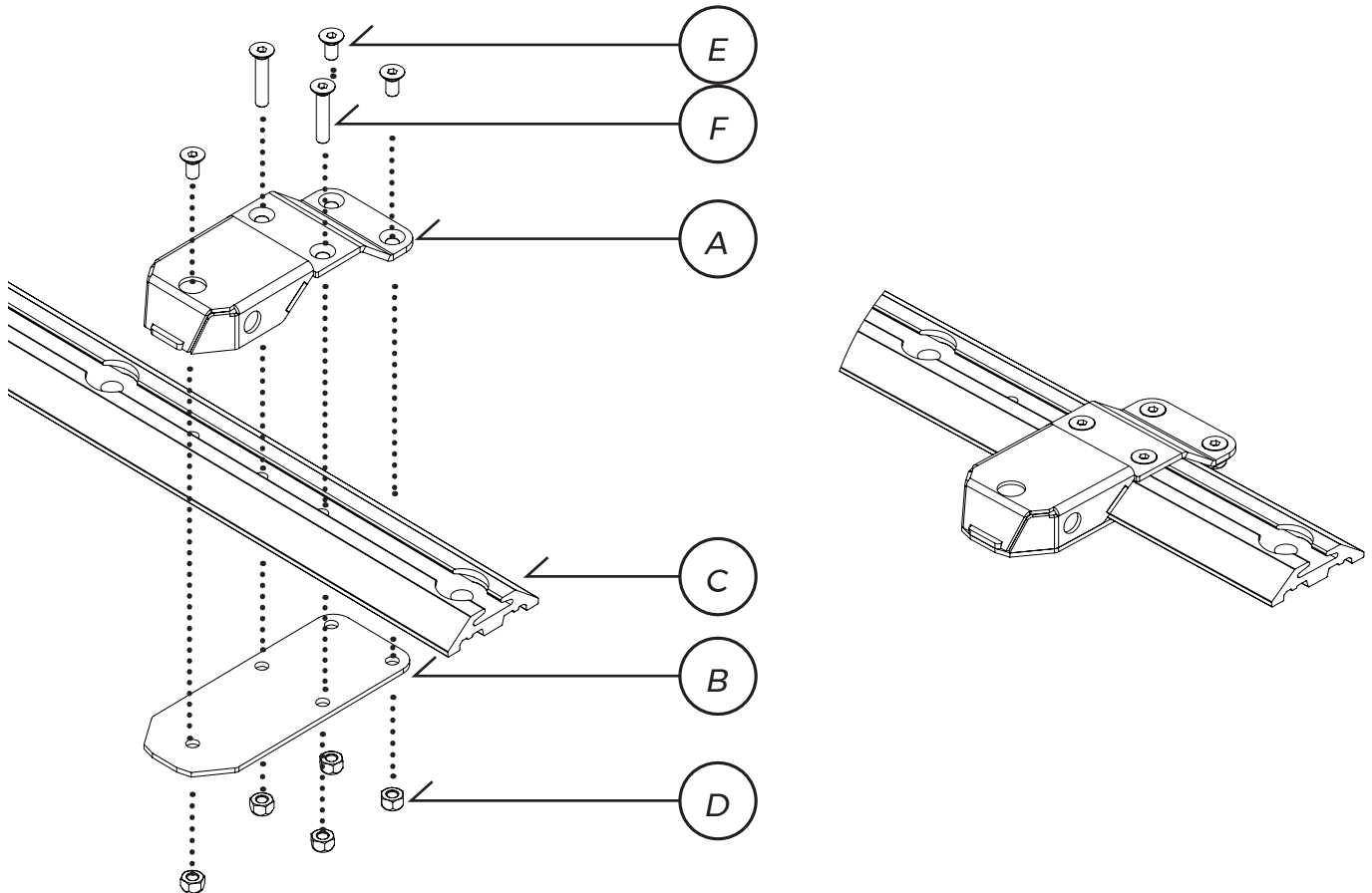
- Securely Assemble the Catch Brackets to the B302 Rail
- Catch Bracket, Single Assembly shown above in exploded view.

- Check and ensure all brackets are 90 degrees to the rail.
- Tighten the Catch Bracket Assembly in all positions shown below. Use hand tools to securely tighten all fasteners.

NOTE: The Catch Brackets use 2 of 3 holes along the rail in each position, note the remaining holes as a guide of the Catch Bracket positions.





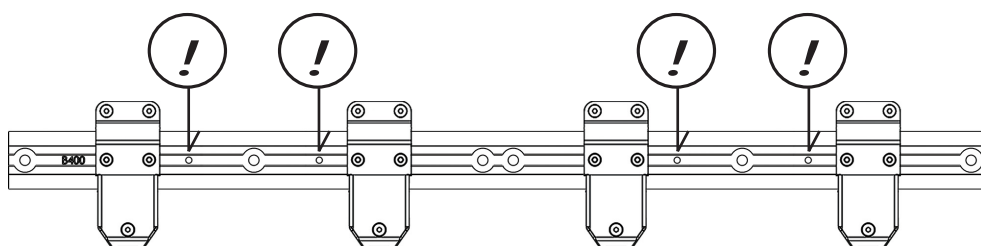
STEP 10 - Click Brackets Assembly:

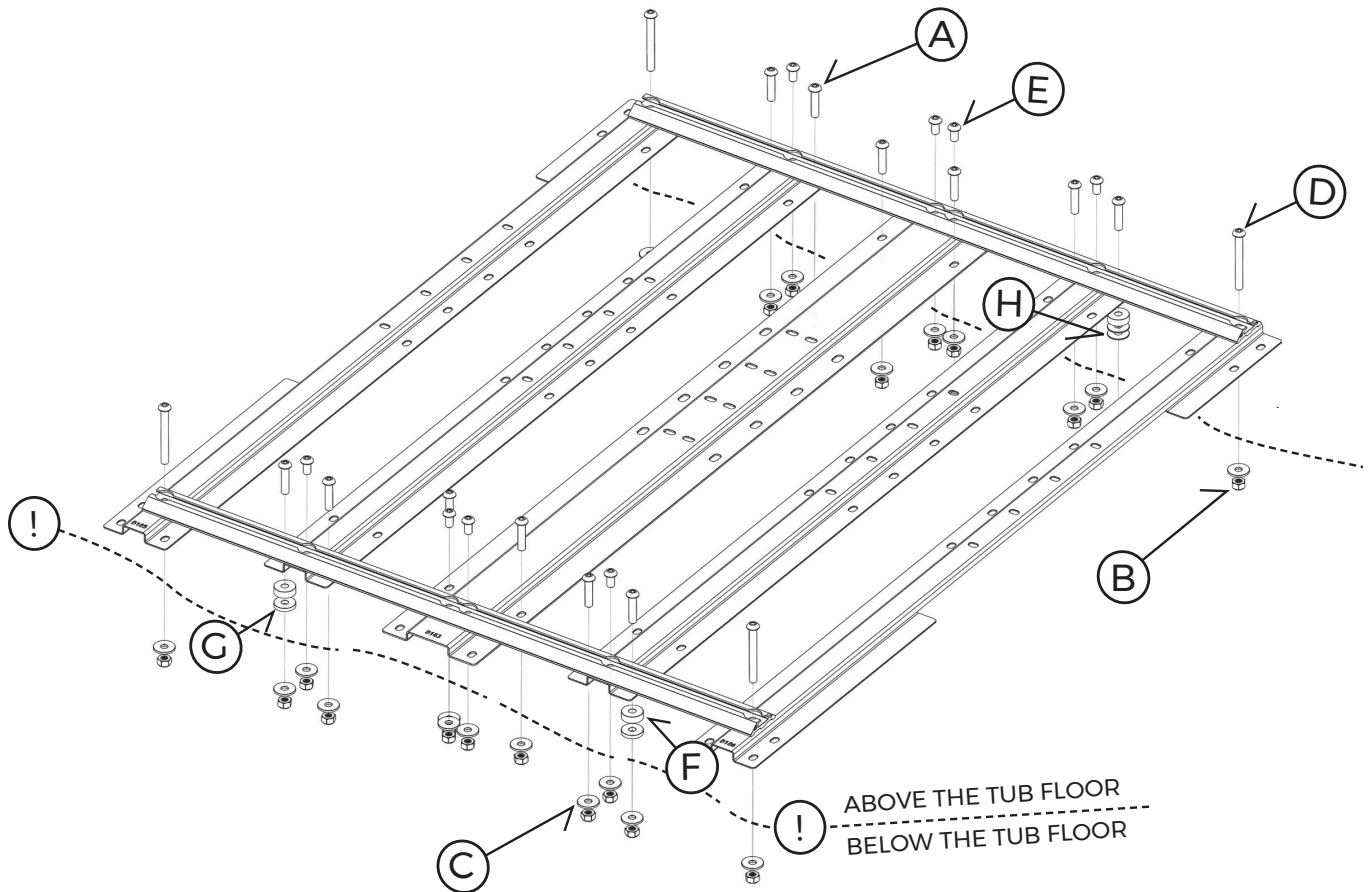
- Securely Assemble the Click Brackets to the B302 Rail
- Catch Bracket, Single Assembly shown above in exploded view.

- Check and ensure all brackets are 90degrees to the rail.
- Tighten the Click Bracket Assembly in all positions shown below. Use hand tools to securely tighten all fasteners.

NOTE: The Click Brackets use 2 of 3 holes along the rail in each position, note the remaining holes as a guide of the Click Bracket positions.

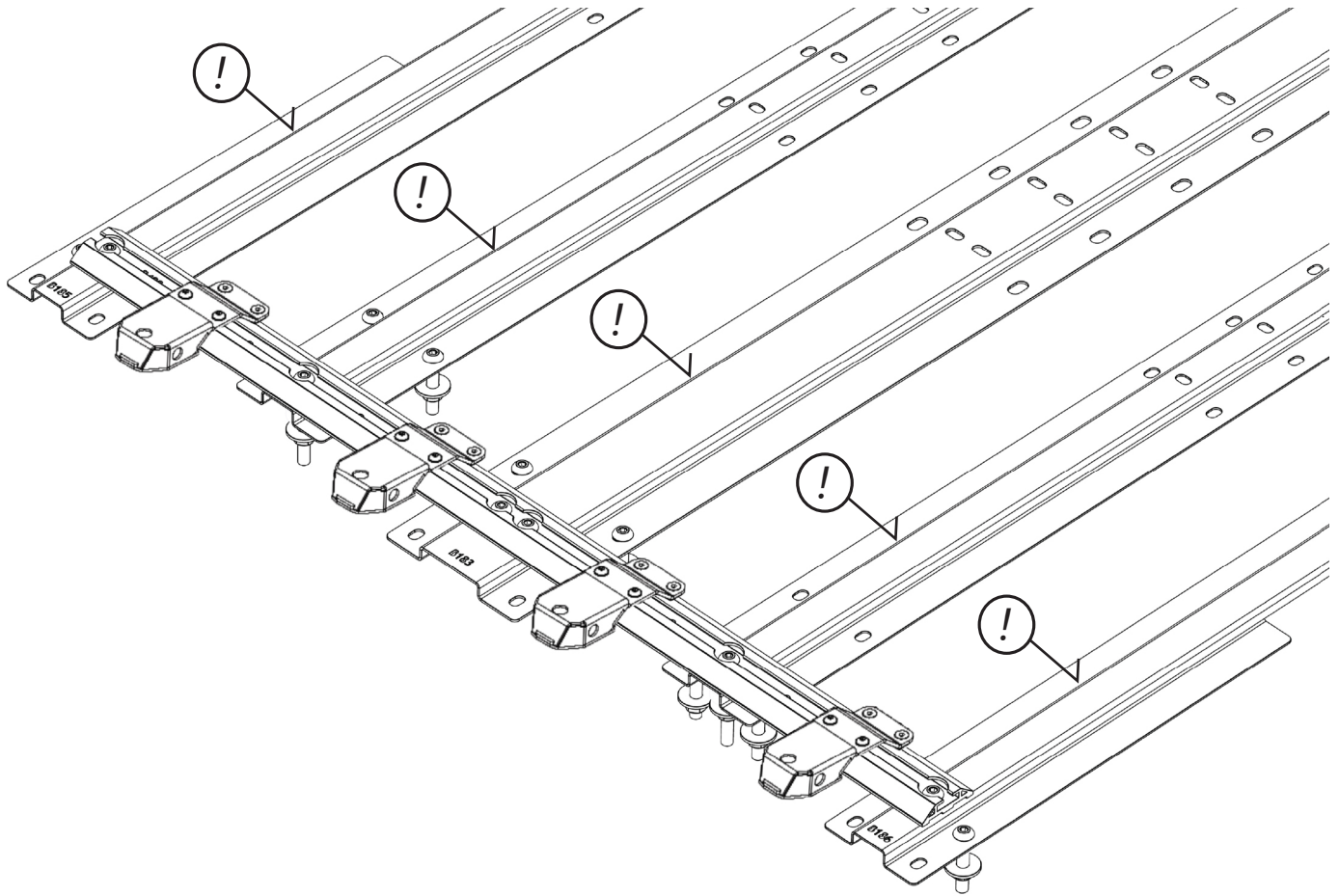




STEP 11 - Secure the 1400 Mounting Platform to the Ute Bed:

- Position the pre-assembled Rails above the B185, B186, B187 and B183 Rails, align them to the drilled holes, refer to the diagram for correct bolt lengths, and use Spacer Discs under the Rails (above ute tub floor) to level the Mounting Platform.
- Hand tighten using hand tools only.

**STEP 12 - Fasten the 1400 Mounting Platform to the Ute Bed:**

- Apply Washers and M10 Lock Nuts to the M10 Bolts
- Securely tighten the fasteners using hand tools.
- Do not overtighten. Stop before damaging or crushing the vehicle

TIP: Check if the assembly requires Spacer Discs that prevent crushing or damage.



NOTE: B185, B186, B187 and B183 Rails should not bow or buckle or curve after tightening of fasteners. These Rails should remain flat to allow the secure and reliable attachment of the KUFU Drawer System. Check to ensure the Tub-liner does not interfere with rails and is not causing the rails to bend or curve.

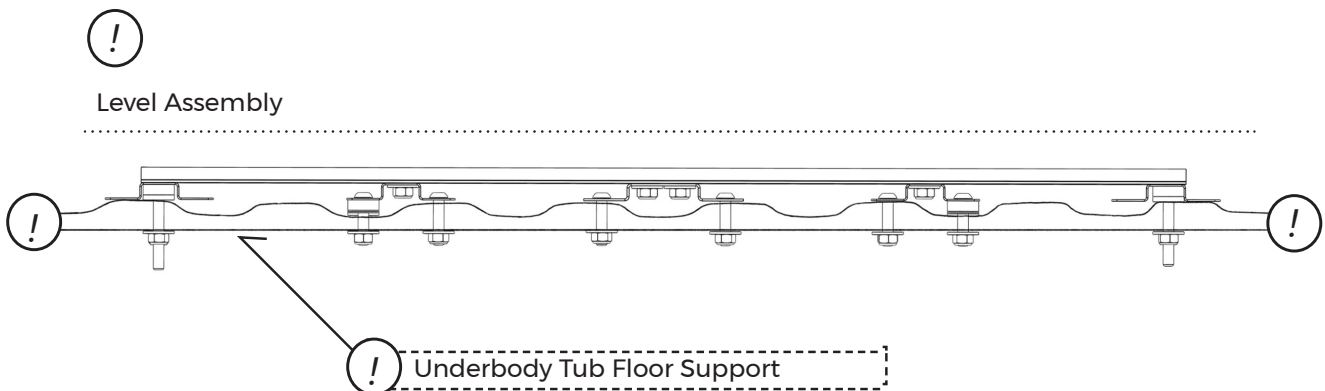
STEP 13 - Check the Level :

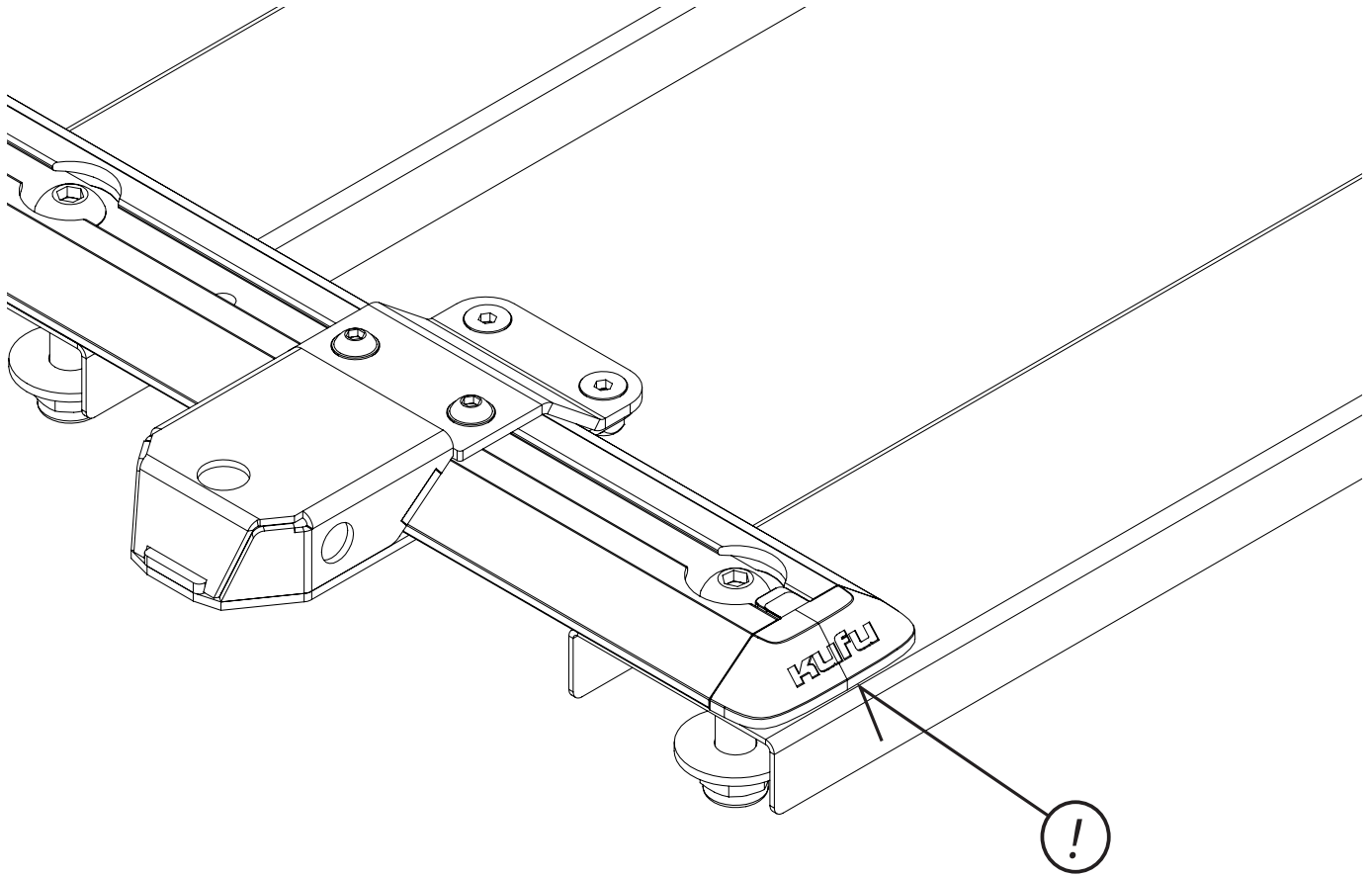
- Ensure the Catch Rail Assembly and Click Rail Assembly are level across the floor of the vehicle.



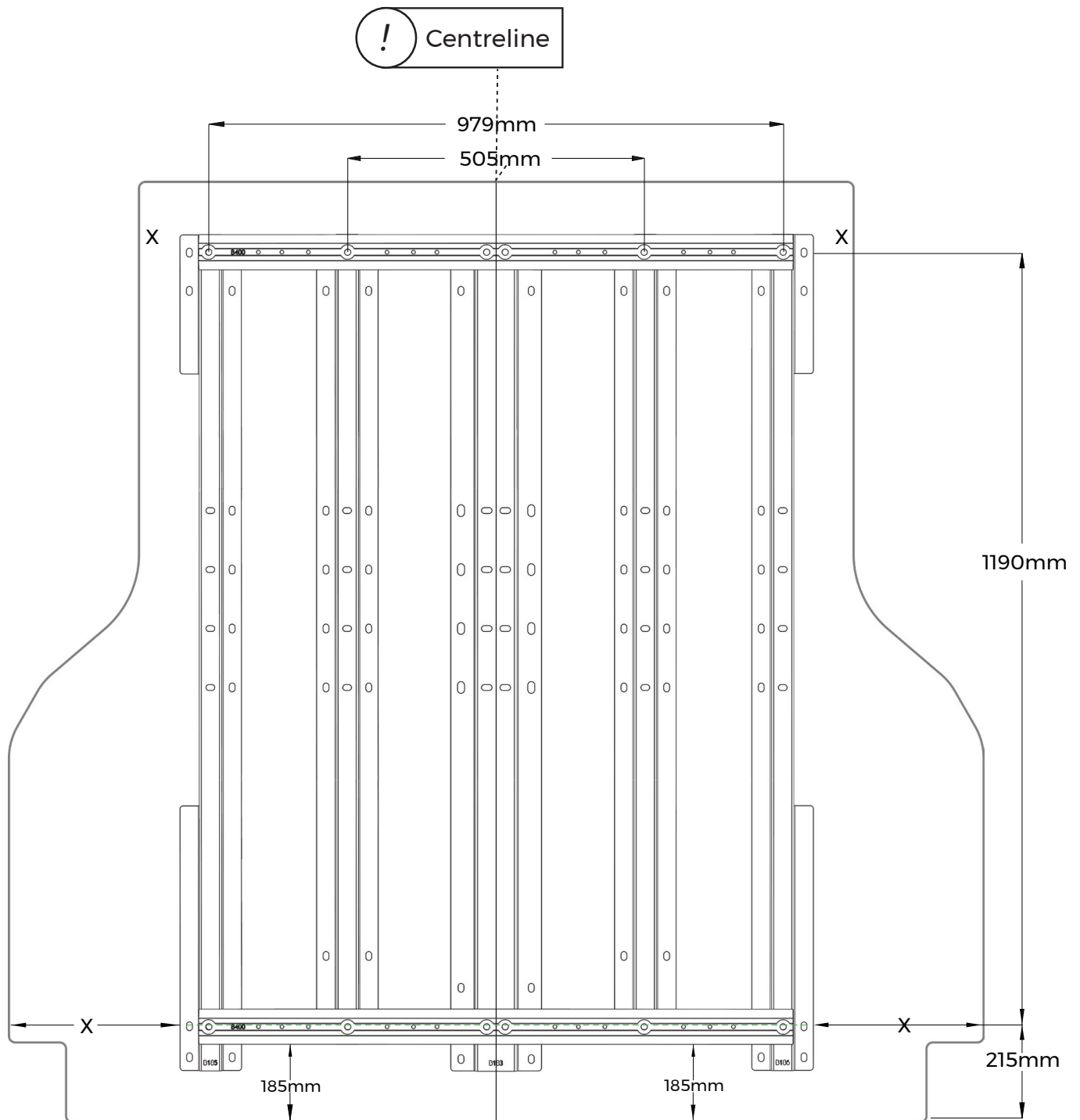
NOTE: Some bolt down positions may require extra-stacked Spacer Discs to make the assembly level. See Example Cross Section View below.

NOTE: If you find a variance that requires a smaller size spacer, than the supplied 10mm and 20mm Spacers, the spacers are easily cut with a hacksaw or you can adjust with M10 x 30mm washers, due to variations and in some cases tub floor damage, it is necessary to source washers or modify spacers.



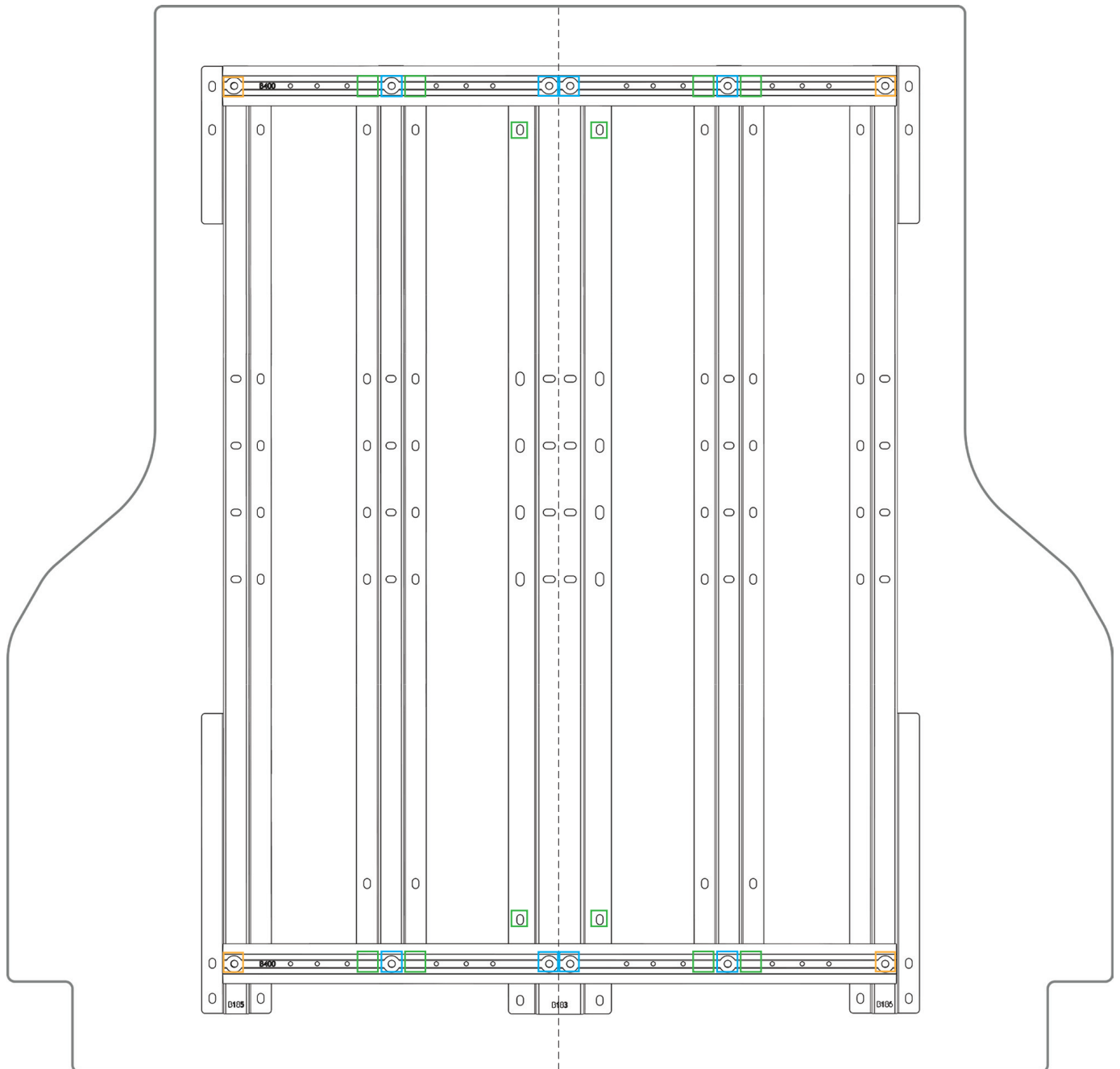
**STEP 14 - Assemble End Caps:**

- Assemble the End Caps x4 positions.



STEP 15 - Layout for Reference:

- Above is a plan view layout of the finished assembly for reference.
- The assembly is shown in a vehicle ute / truck bed outline for reference.
- Note the centreline of the vehicle aligns with the centre of the 1400 Mounting Platform.
- There is additional space allowed at the tailgate of the ute bed for the installation of the drawer system and clearance for the closing tailgate.



- Above is a layout marked with the positions of bolts used.
- The positions marked with “” are for M10x20.
- The positions marked with “” are for M10x45.
- The positions marked with “” are for M10x90.
